

iStar 7-in 1 Safety Car Charger PI00670 with built-in power bank & torch

This multifunction 7-in-1 car charger includes a safety hammer, belt cutter, alarm and 3 mode torch. It also functions as a power bank with a built-in lithium battery rechargeable via a DC car socket or USB port. The charger also features overcharge, over discharge, overload and short circuit protection, to extend the life of the built-in battery and the battery of your USB devices.

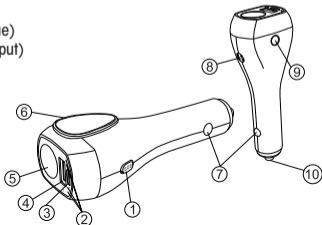

Safety Warnings

This product is not a toy and could cause injury or damage to property if handled incorrectly; please keep it away from children under 6 years of age.

- The concealed point of the Safety Hammer ⑩ is sharp be careful not to touch it.
- This charger is not waterproof, please do not expose to liquids. If the unit gets wet, use a clean cloth to absorb water on the unit's surface. If liquid has entered the sockets or housing, use a hair drier on very low heat to dry the unit to avoid a short circuit.
- This product contains a Lithium battery. It must be used and charged properly. Improper use can cause the battery to catch fire or explode resulting in serious or fatal injury.
- Do not leave the item in direct sunlight, temperatures over 70°C, will damage the built-in battery.
- If the product is not charging properly:
 - 1) Check if the adaptor is suitable for your device.
 - 2) If the unit has shut down automatically you will need charge the built-in battery.
 - 3) If the charger has not been used for six months or more the built-in battery will lose its charge. Check the charge (press the Check Charge button ⑨ if only 1 LED is lit you will need to charge the unit before using it to charge your mobile phone. Use the USB cable provided to connect to a powered USB socket and charge the for 2-3 hours.
- To prolong the battery life, charge the unit fully at least once every 6 months.

In-Car Charging and USB Charging

In-Car Charging - using the cigarette lighter socket

Step 1: Plug the charger into a car cigarette lighter DC socket, the blue LED will start flashing to indicate there is power.

Step 2: Use the micro USB cable provided to connect your device to the car charger USB DC out port ④.

Tip: If you are charging an iPhone/iPad, use your original cable to connect it to the charger USB DC out port ④.

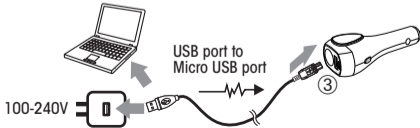
Step 3: While charging, the blue LED indicator will start to flash, when the battery is fully charged, all four blue indicators will be lit.

PLEASE NOTE: In some vehicles the DC socket will only work when the ignition is switched on or the engine is running.



USB Charging - using a PC, laptop or USB adaptor

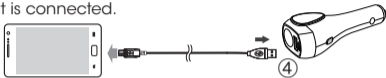
To charge the built-in battery of the charger connect the micro USB cable provided to the DC input port of the charger ③ and connect it to a powered USB port on a PC, laptop or USB mains adaptor. The blue LED indicator will start to flash, when the battery is fully charged, all four blue indicators will be lit.



Power Bank & Torch Functions

Once your charger is charged via USB

Step 1: Use the micro USB cable to connect the charger to your USB device. The charging indicator on your device will show when it is connected.



Note 1: If your device's charging port is not a micro USB (e.g. on an iPhone), please use the original cable supplied with your device to connect to the charger.

Note 2: The charger will automatically start charging your device when connected to it.

Using the built in 3 mode LED torch

- 1) Press and hold down the LED torch button (9) for about 1.5 seconds to switch on the LED torch at medium strength.
- 2) Press again to switch to full beam
- 3) Press a third time for a white flashing light
- 4) Press hold down the LED torch button (9) in any mode to switch off the torch.

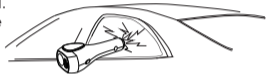


Hammer, Belt Cutter & Alarm Functions

Using the safety hammer

The safety hammer feature is designed to help you break a car window/windscreen to allow you to escape or free someone from a car in which the doors are jammed shut. The hammer is concealed in the positive pole of the charger plug ⑩. Hold the car charger in your hand and strike the window with the narrow end.

Tips: Make sure you hold the charger at right angles to the glass for best results.



Using the safety seat belt cutter

If after an accident a seat belt cannot be released normally you can use the blade ⑥ concealed in the torch end of the charger to cut the fabric of the belt. Hold the narrow end of the charger, hook the blade over the belt and pull the charger towards you.

Pull back and forth to cut through the fabric of the belt.



Activating the personal alarm

Slide the SOS switch ① on the side of the charger to the up position to activate the alarm. Slide the switch down to stop.

Note 1: For maximum volume make sure you don't cover the Alarm Speaker outlet ⑧ with your hand.

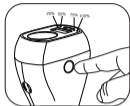


Checking Battery Capacity

Checking Battery Capacity

To check the charge status of the charger, press the capacity indicator button ⑨

- If 4 of the blue LED indicators ② are lit, the capacity is at 100%.
- If 3 of the blue LED indicators ② are lit, capacity is at 75%.
- If 2 of the blue LED indicators ② are lit the capacity is at 50%.
- If 1 of the blue LED indicators ② is lit the capacity is at 25%.
